**SCIENCEABC - Science Applications Becoming Culture.** The conference is organized as a moment for sharing the results of scientific research in the field of sciences applied to cultural heritage. The heterogeneity of the materials of cultural heritage causes conservation scientists to be specialized in different fields of science. Therefore, the meeting allows to bring together the contributions not on the basis of the topic or the techniques used, but rather including the different fields of science that study the ancient materials constituting the works of art or innovative materials for conservation and restoration.

Furthermore, the importance of the meeting is also given by the involvement of high school students in order to promote the work and the figure of the conservation scientist.

**Submission deadline of abstracts for oral and poster presentation is Friday 20th December 2019.** To promote the participation the fees are minimized and the Italian Society of Specialists in Science applied to Cultural Heritages – ANEDbc will sponsor two grants covering the inscription fees for young researchers.

After a first successful edition, with more than 160 contributions and 170 assistants belonging to 29 different nationalities, we have considered to organise the 2nd Palaeontological Virtual Congress (2nd PVC) with the same

purpose of spreading worldwide the most recent scientific advances in palaeontology in a fast, easy and economical way. This new edition will take place on May 2020, being exclusively developed in a virtual environment, and organising by a young group of researches belonging to the Universitat de València, Museu Valencià d'Història Natural and Museo Paleontológico de Alpuente (Spain), the University of Bath and the University of Bristol (UK), and Universidad Nacional de La Plata (Argentina). Oral communications and posters about any palaeontological field will be presented through an online platform created ad hoc. The simplicity of this new format will allow for low-cost registration fees (5€) and saving travel and maintenance expenses for the delegates. **XV International Palynological Congress - XI International Organization of Palaeobotany Conference 200 Years of Palaeobotany 12-19 September, 2020 - Prague, Czech Republic**

Since 2009, the world community of palynologists and palaeobotanists has met every four years to discuss the latest research, and to exchange experiences. The meeting is promoted by the collective efforts of the International Federation of Palynological Societies (IFPS) and the International Organisation of Palaeobotany (IOP). Every talk consists of 15 minutes for oral presentation and 5 minutes for discussion. Every paying participant can present one talk as a speaker or can show one poster. Individual participants can be co-author (not speaker) of more than one talk and poster. Organizers in some cases may change the character of contributions from a talk to a poster presentation based on time and space pressures, and also room availability. The Department of Botany at the Faculty of Biology, University of Innsbruck, Austria, is looking to fill a **Senior Scientist (Doctorate/PhD) position in Classical and Molecular Palaeoecology (Code BIO-10960)**

**Start date/duration:** from 01.01.2020; for 4 years, possibility for a permanent position depending on requirement and performance evaluation. **Extent of employment:** 40 hours per week

**Job Description:** Applications are invited for a **Senior Scientist position** within the Unit of Plant Evolution and Diversity of the Department of Botany of the University of Innsbruck, initially for 4 years, with possibility of conversion to permanent position. The job holder will carry out independent high-level research in the field of classical and molecular palaeoecology, with responsibility for the pollen forecast service for the Austrian federal state of Tyrol and collaboration with the national pollen forecast service of Austria. The jobholder is expected to acquire external funding, collaborate internally and internationally and contribute to the departmental high-impact publication output.
